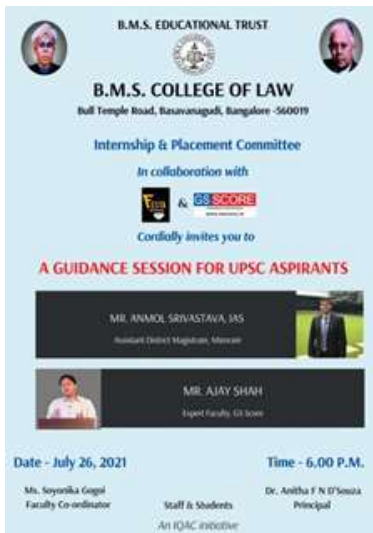
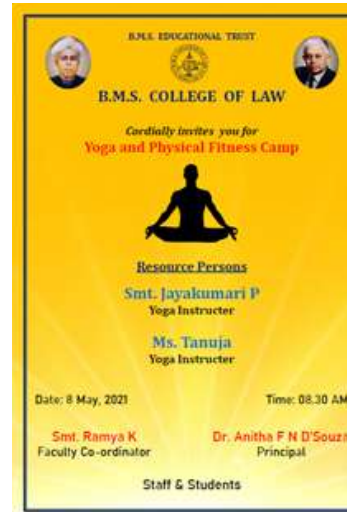


A Webinar on "Legal Remedies for the protection of Human Rights in India" was organized by the Human Rights Cell on 24 July, 2021.
