Green and Safe Deepavali Celebration!!

The Legal Awareness Cell of BMS College of Law, Bangalore organized legal awareness programme in Government PU College, Wadia Road, Basavanagudi, Bangalore on 30 October, 2021.

Dr. Sujatha, Assistant Professor, BMS College of Law, Bangalore, addressed the students on the topic 'Significance of celebration of Deepavali in a safe manner'. The history behind the celebration of Deepavali is to remember the defeat of evil spirit by Lord Rama who was deprived of his kingdom and sent to exile for 14 years. People celebrate Deepavalito commemorate Rama's eventual defeat of the evil spirit of Ravana and his triumphant return to his kingdom. Deepavali illuminates our inner self and the lights of self-reflection. Deepavali is celebration of Prosperity, gives us the strength and the zeal to carry on our work and goodwill for the rest of the year and promising us the success and Prosperity in all future endeavours. It is a festival of-

- Knowledge over Ignorance.

Deepavali is celebrated by lighting the Diya's, not by bursting crackers. She urged the students to celebrateSafe Deepavali only by lighting Diya's so that you can save nature, environment and eradicate the child labour in the society.



The speaker also explained about the effects of firecrackers like pollution of environment, fire hazards, noise pollution, etc which will degrade our health and poses threat to our lives. It also affects the lives of animals. Further, she discussed about the precautions to be taken while bursting crackers which includes wearing cotton dresses and adopt other safety measures.

Miss Amritha Shree, 6th semester, 5 YrLL. Bexplained about the role of Honourable Supreme Court of India in banning bursting of crackers during Deepavali festival in Delhi as Delhi stands as most polluted capital in the world through its landmark judgement in Arjun Gopal v. UOI and MC Mehta VS. State of Tamil Nadu.

In 1996 in MC Mehta judgement, the SC issued certain important directives to ensure compliance with the child labour (Prohibition and Regulation Act)1986.

Dr. Gayathri Bai S spoke on the topic 'Bursting of Crackers and Child Labour. Child labour is a curse in Indian society because of which many children are sent to factories to earn livelihood and feed their families. Most of the children are working in fireworks factories in different places in India specially in Shivakasi, Tamil Nadu. The main reason for the child labour in India is poverty because of which children are dropped out from the schools and made to work in factories. As per Child Labour (prohibition) Act, Child Labour is prohibited in India, but because of various reasons we find child labour increasing in India. The speaker highlighted about how children are subjected to risk when they work in fireworks factories, sometimes they lose their lives also and many children are injured due to accidents in fireworks factories. She urged the students not to burst crackers during the festivals as it indirectly encourages to manufacture the crackers to meet the demands of the purchasers which leads to child labour. She also urged the students to create awareness in their neighborhoods about the harm which may be caused by bursting of crackers.

Ms. Bharathvarshini. 6th Semester, B.A LLB Course spoke about the 'Right to Environment'. She spoke about the fundamental duty imposed on citizens as per Indian Constitution to protect the environment and she also spoke about the Precautionary and Polluters Pay principle according to which the manufacturer is liable to pay damages to the victims.

The programme was concluded by interactive session during which many questions were raised by the students and it was well answered by the speakers in a very accusative manner.

Outcome of the programme: Around 300 students participated in the awareness programme and students voluntarily took oath to celebrate Deepavali by lighting Diya's and not bursting
